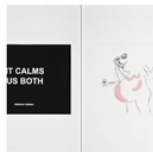

In this monoprint by Allison Miller, simple forms—here, a large semi-rectangular shape and a veiled but colorful and patterned circle—take on surprisingly life-like qualities. 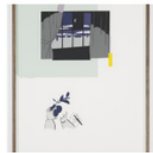

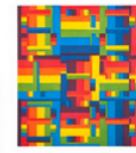

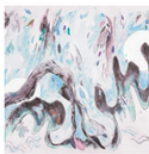
