

"Robyn O'Neil: I Want Blood"

There's an otherworldly quality to Robyn O'Neil's graphite-on-paper drawings: featureless heads, rain-laden clouds and spectral shapes drifting across stormy landscapes. Despite the eeriness of these works, they're a marked departure from her portentous seven-feet-by-fourteen-feet triptych, *HELL* (2011), containing 35,000 separate collage elements. For her first solo show at Western Exhibitions and away from *HELL*, O'Neil introduces subtle bursts of color, popping from the muted background like remembered snippets of an otherwise foggy dream. (Or is it nightmare?)
