The Collection: With conceptual artist Beverly Semmes as her muse (she of the elongated fabric/dress installations) designer Doo.Ri Chung was freed to take her signature draping to next level, as it were. That level was far south of the knee, with languid jersey draped-hem dresses that curved around the calf, and vests, coats and sweaters that trailed behind the models as they stalked the runway. All came in soothing shades of black, ivory, midnight blue and charcoal—and most of the looks were worn with perfectly spare white ankle booties (Obsessed!) or sexy lace-front thigh high boots.

The Standout Piece(s): There were many: A full-length vest worn with matching cropped trousers and an asymmetrical draped halter; a looong grey fringed mohair scarf; a terrifically cut, terrifically spare grey flannel draped back top with matching seamed trousers; a draped back oversized mohair pullover; and charcoal felted jersey coats with either a coordinating wool wrap scarf or fox fur lapels, all of which add up to the perfect winter wardrobe.
